

- ☐ **STONES** regular visual check.
If the stones have settled, remove them completely. Clean the rock store and clear it of brittle stones with deposits, stone fragments and residues. Replace with correctly sized stones suitable for the heater. Loosely stack stones again to achieve sufficient air flow.
- ☐ **ACCESSORIES**
Check if all attached parts such as brackets, heater guard rail, stack frames, sand timers, hygrometers, thermometers, etc. are still properly mounted?
- ☐ **DISTANCES** to flammable parts.
Is the heater still in the original location? Were flammable parts retrofitted near the heater?
See safety distances in the respective operating instructions.
- ☐ **SUPPLY AIR & EXHAUST AIR OPENING** check.
Check that all air vents are not closed or blocked. Clean them as necessary to ensure the free airflow.
- ☐ **FUNCTION** of all sauna components.
Check if all components, like e.g. switches work correctly? Are there visible damages to the sauna components? For instance, the lighting, heater, control unit, cables, etc.
- ☐ **SAFETY DEVICES**
If available, check for function and stable mounting.
- ☐ **VISUAL CONDITION OF THE WOODEN SURFACES** check.
If there is rapid and significant darkening in the area around the sauna heater, the ventilation, air circulation or the installation of the sauna heater (clearances) must be checked. Dark spots usually indicate excessive exposure to temperature. By some sauna heaters this can indicate poor filling of sauna stones - directly visible heating elements can cause burns on wooden surfaces.
- ☐ **BASE AREA OF THE SAUNA HEATER**
Check and clean the sauna stone particles or other residues in the bottom tray of the heater.
- ☐ **CLEANING** of painted and unpainted metal parts.
Clean the corresponding material and surface finish at regular intervals, as well as all other sauna components, with suitable cleaning agents.
- ☐ **VAPORIZER TANK** regularly check.
Make regular visual check for scale deposits. Clean and descale as necessary at regular intervals with suitable cleaning agents. Check your local water hardness level.
